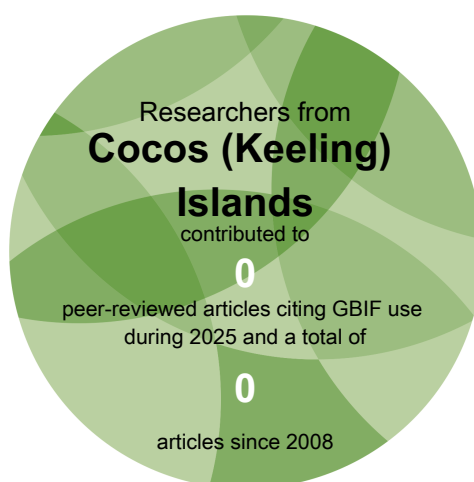

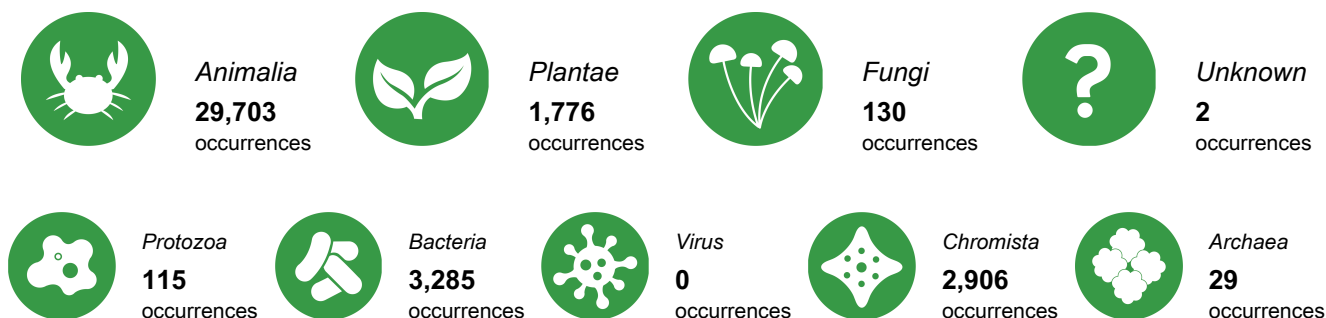
Cocos (Keeling) Islands

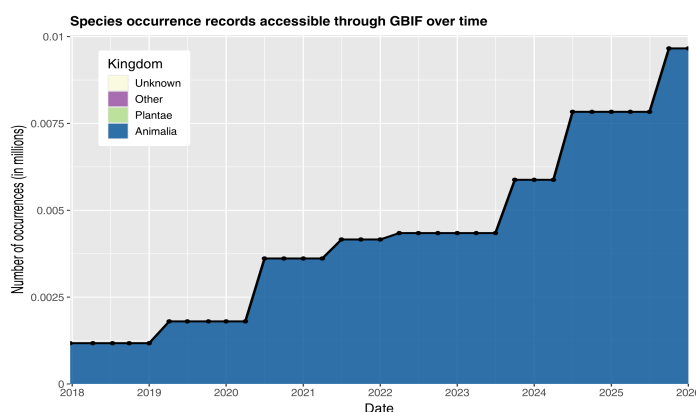
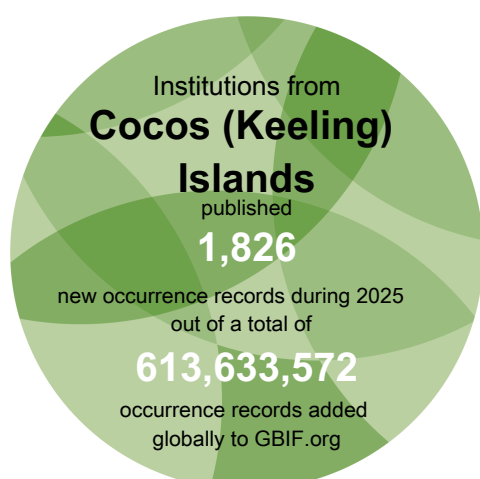

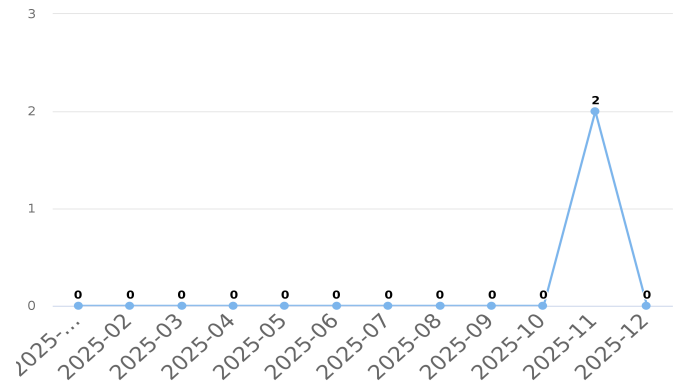
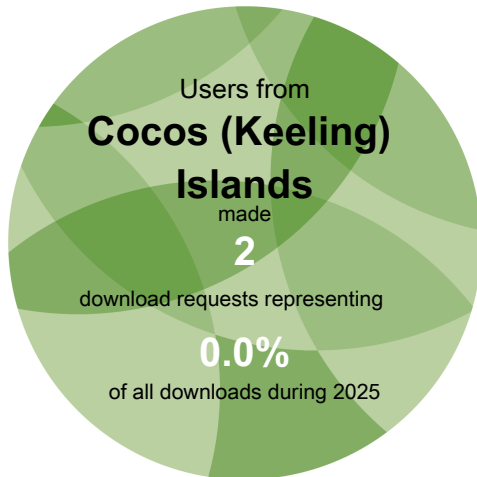


Number of records published by institutions in Cocos (Keeling) Islands, categorized by kingdom

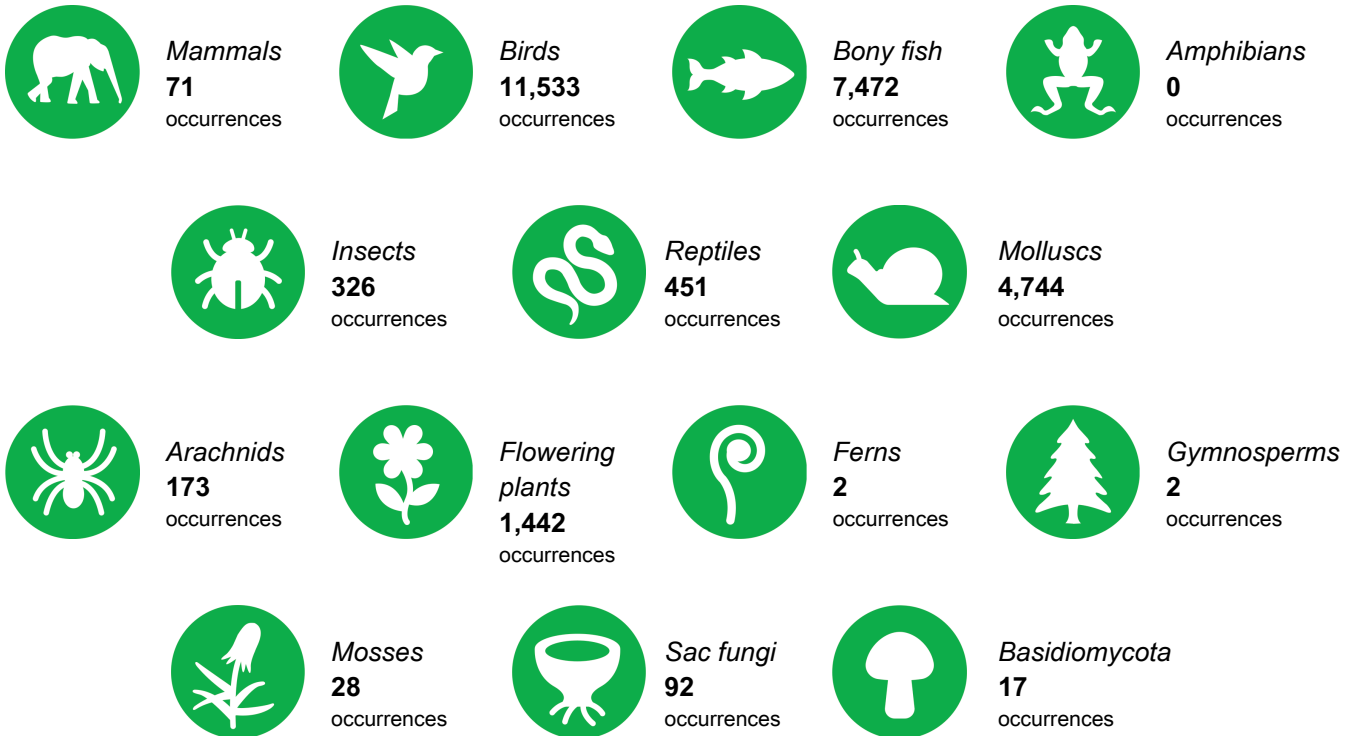


Monthly downloads requested by users in Cocos (Keeling) Islands

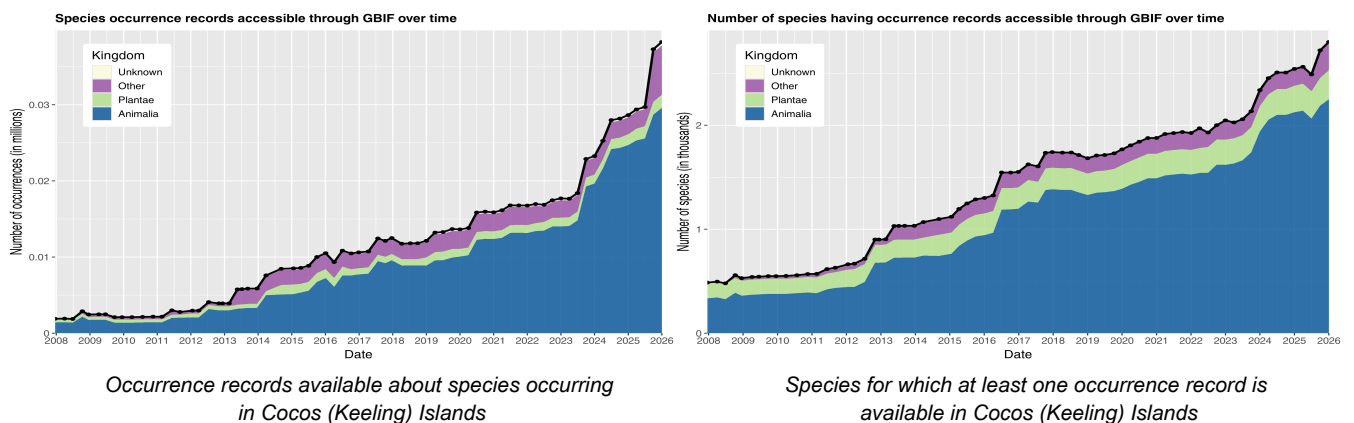

WHY MIGHT THE AMOUNT OF MOBILIZED DATA DECREASE?

Datasets are sometimes removed by publishers, but more often decreases in the number of records are due to the removal of duplicate records and datasets.

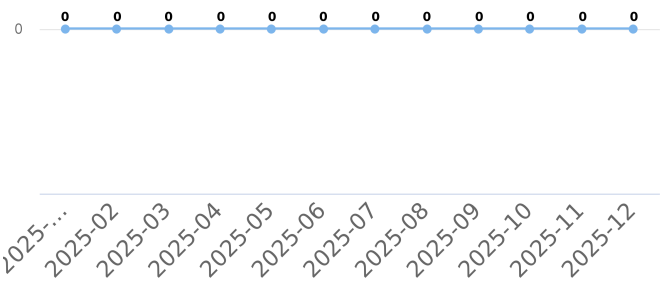

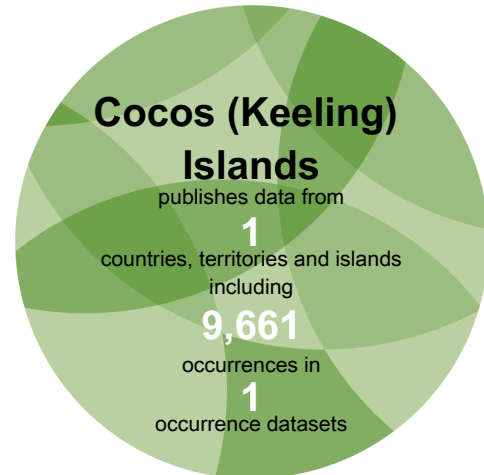
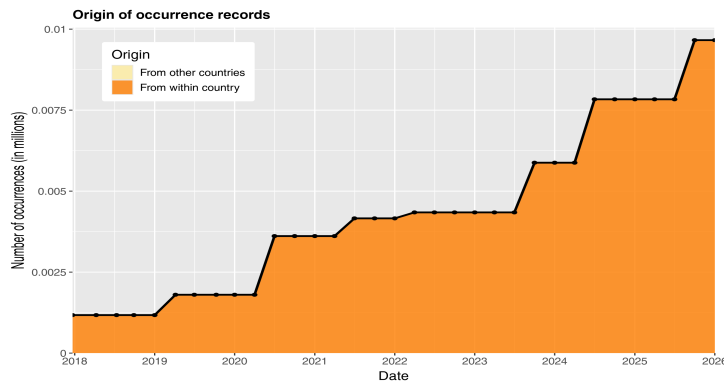
