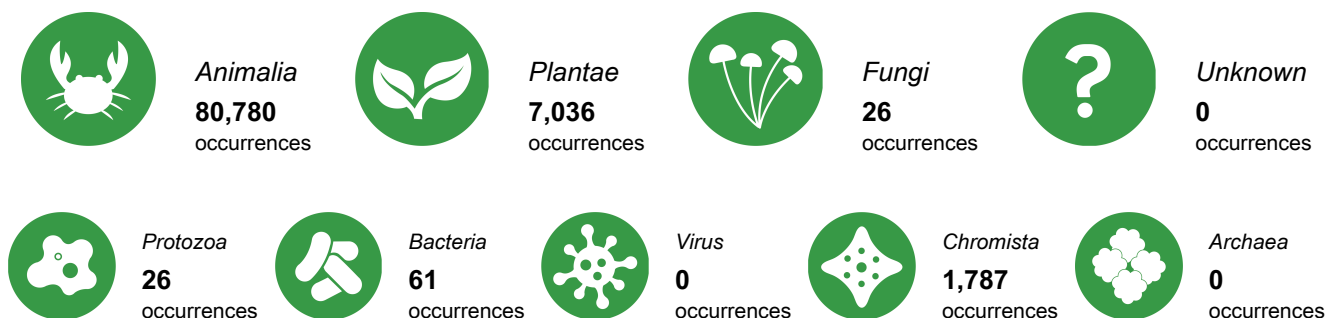
Saint Martin (French part)

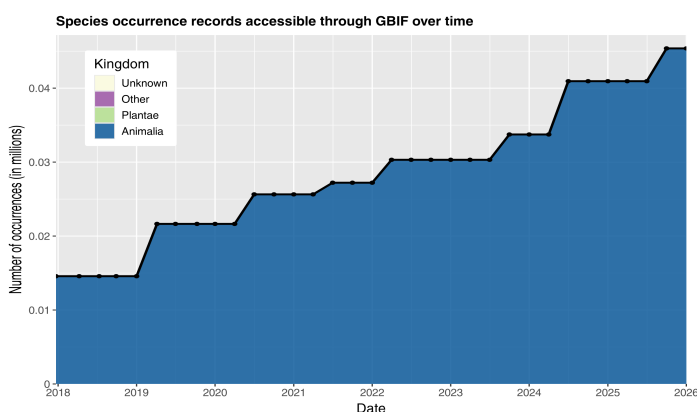

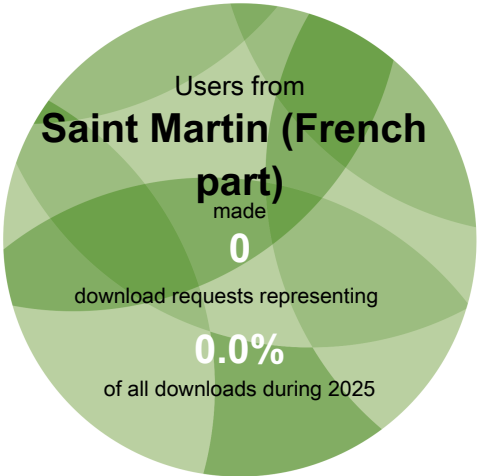


Number of records published by institutions in Saint Martin (French part), categorized by kingdom

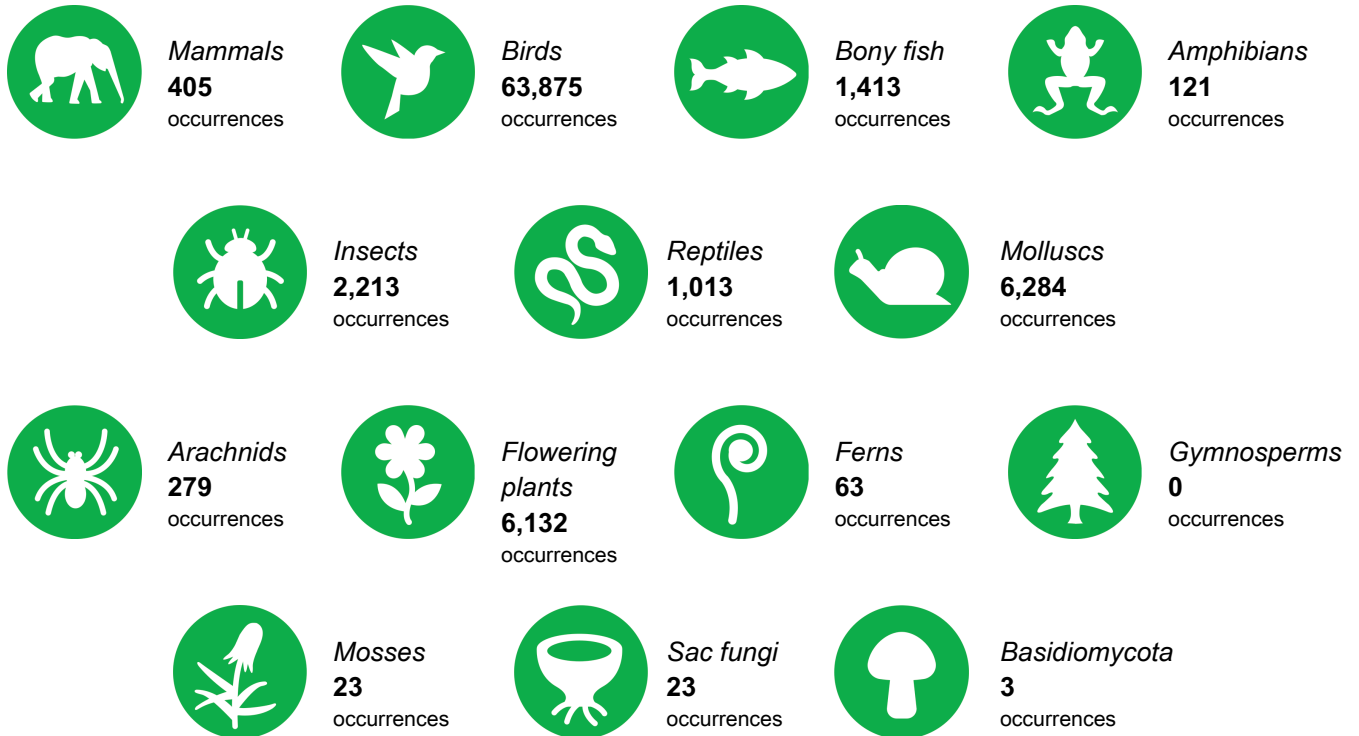

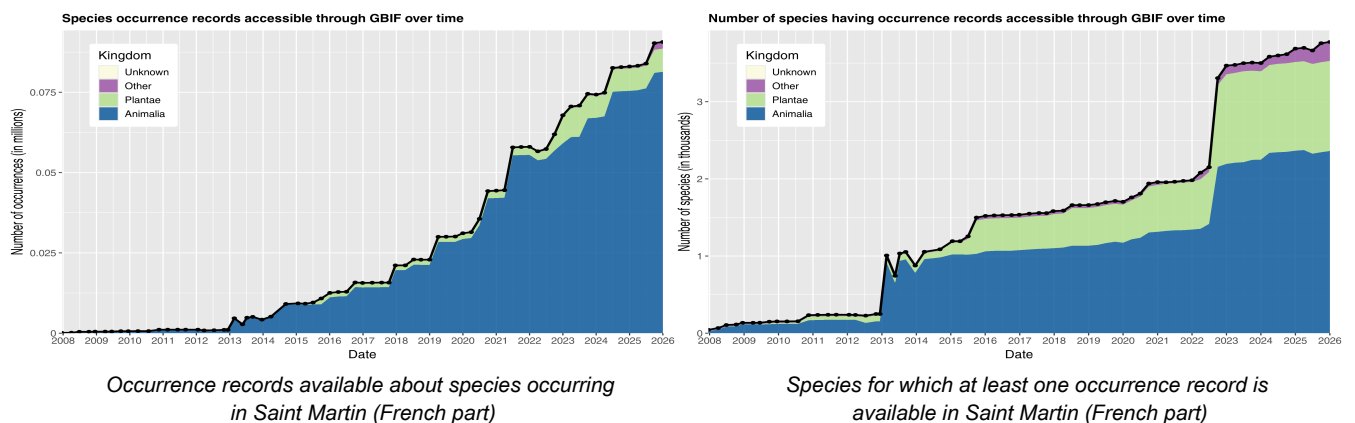

WHY MIGHT THE AMOUNT OF MOBILIZED DATA DECREASE?

Datasets are sometimes removed by publishers, but more often decreases in the number of records are due to the removal of duplicate records and datasets.

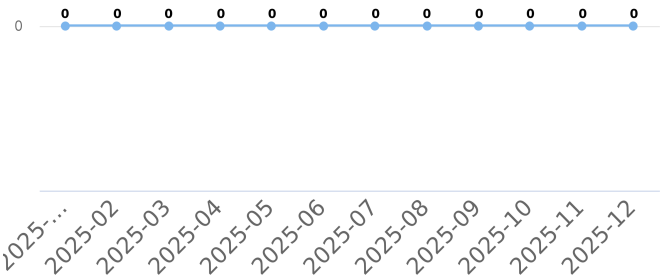

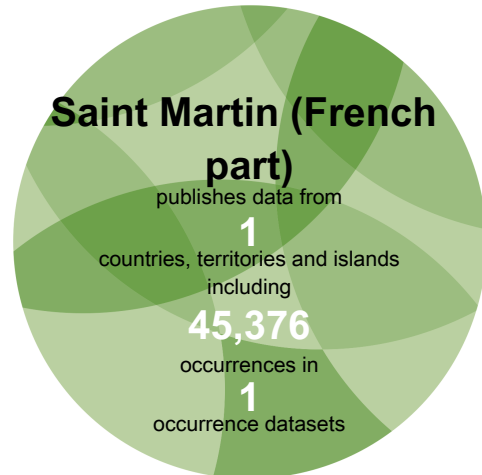
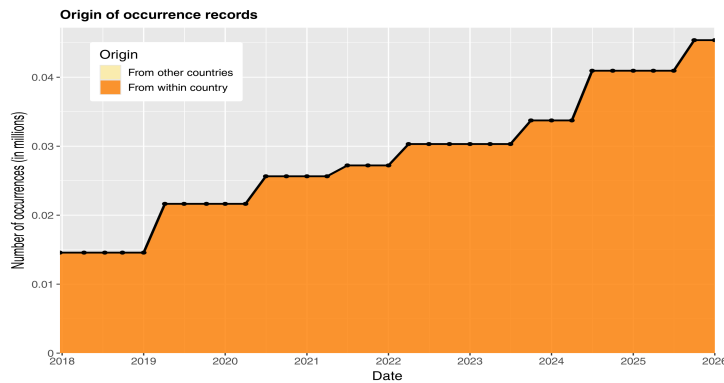
